Tuition for 2010:

As announced a couple of times, the tuition for the European Bible School changed for 2010.

There will still be **2 groups** according to the countries the students come from:

Group A: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Norway, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom.

Group B: Albania, Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey, Ukraine.

- If a church sends **one full student** (coming to all sessions in 2010), the tuition will be for 700.- EUR (Group A) / 450 EUR (Group B) for the year 2010.

This includes a 2010 E-learning access, which offers all the notes, MP3's, videos and tests.

- There will still be **flat rates**, yet for organizational reasons (E-learning) the flat rate students need to be specified and named.

The **Flat-5** would be 2500.- / 1800.-

The **Flat-10** would be 4500.- / 3200.-

A new **Flat-15** would be 6200.- / 4500.-

All flat rates include a 2010 E-learning access for the flat rate students, which offer all the notes, MP3's, videos and tests.

- A **one-time-visitor** (coming to a session only once) will pay 300.- / 150.- per session.

- Those churches, which decide for a flat rate, will receive a discount for **additional one-time visitors** (200.- / 100.- per person and session)

- Wives will be asked to pay a small tuition fee (50.- / 30.- per wife and session)

- Additional online accesses for the E-learning will be available as usual (300.- / 200 .- for one year)

Please decide and wire the tuition fees before **March 15th, 2010**. For payment-details please check our website www.european-bible-school.org.
